Playground Section

The following sub-items that create non-compliance items are able to be corrected during the assessment visit. The QAA must be able to verify the item is now in compliance prior to them leaving the centre, otherwise the item will remain a non-compliance.

Domain	Sub-Items
1. Supervision of Children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Items cannot be CDA
2. Outdoor Play Space & Shade Area	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Items cannot be CDA
3. Physical Play Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No balls available • Balls are not inflated • No additional developmentally appropriate physical play equipment is available • Staff set up physical play equipment to facilitate participation
4. Learning Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Insufficient amount of learning materials for the number of children wanting to use them • Learning materials are not in good condition • Learning materials reflect the interests of the children • Learning materials are developmentally appropriate
5. Wheeled Toys	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No wheeled toys available • Wheeled toys are not in good condition • Only one type of wheeled toys available • Wheeled toys are developmentally appropriate • One large winter toy for every four children is available
6. Outdoor Storage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Items cannot be CDA each other in an unsafe manner
